We have now passed an important stage in this lengthy application, as the YFS panel has approved our application. It has now been passed to the full Surrey County Council Cabinet for its approval later in October.

So, fingers crossed that it all goes well, as we can then resurface the car park area and lane with new hard core and tarmac surface. There will be two passing places in the lane, electric rechargeable points in the car park and a pond for the water run off located at the lowest point.
