

Overview of Events

- 19–21 September 2025 – National Youth Gathering (AMYA UK): A spiritual, academic, and sporting retreat for young members of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Youth Association. The event is alcohol-free and designed to promote community cohesion, healthy living, and moral development.
- 26–28 September 2025 – National Gathering for Women and Elderly Groups: A parallel weekend event with a similar programme, providing an inclusive environment for women and elderly participants within our community.

Attendance and Vehicles:

1. Expected Attendees (per day):
 - Friday: 600
 - Saturday: 1500-1800
 - Sunday: 2100 - 2500 (Similar figures apply for the second weekend.)
2. Expected Cars (per day):
 - Friday: 400
 - Saturday: 1,000
 - Sunday: 1,400 (peak)
3. Peak Car Movements:
 - Friday: Minimal rush due to working hours and schools; steady arrival in late afternoon/evening.
 - Saturday & Sunday: Majority of arrivals between 10:00 –14:00. Departures largely completed by 19:00.
4. On-Site Parking Capacity:
 - Approximately 900 vehicles can be parked on site at any one time.

Traffic and Parking Management

- An external professional traffic management company has been engaged to oversee traffic flow, parking arrangements, and road safety.
- A dedicated team of trained volunteers will support the external provider to ensure smooth coordination and safe management throughout the weekend.
- Staggered arrival communications will be sent to attendees in advance to reduce bottlenecks during peak hours.
- Overflow parking and shuttle arrangements are being prepared should demand exceed on-site capacity at any time.
- Clear signage, marshals, and active monitoring will ensure that access routes remain unobstructed and that any local impact is minimised.
